In February of 2006, the Tampa-based chain of neighborhood wine shops announced three private investment opportunities. Investors can buy and operate a franchise. Since opening the first location in 2004, the Cork & Olive preferred customer database has grown to more than 20,000. Revenues in the last year have increased 400%. The projection is to open 200 stores in Florida within the next three years.
