

Pinellas mall changes store mix

New stores are opening at Westfield Countryside.

A retail wine store, [Cork & Olive](#), and [Southwest Grille](#), a food court addition, will open in early 2007.



In addition to the new openings, the shopping mall recently opened [Too Jays](#), Marks and Morgan Jewelers, Vans and [Zumiez](#).

Too Jays is a New York-style delicatessen and restaurant located on the upper level near JC Penney. Marks and Morgan is a jeweler that was founded in 1901.

Vans is a sports footwear company, while Zumiez is a skateboarding and snowboarding gear, clothing and accessories store.

Located on U.S. Highway 19, Westfield Countryside was acquired by the [Westfield Group](#) in 2002. It is home to four major department stores, [Dillard's](#), [JCPenney](#),

[Macy's](#) and [Sears](#) and more than 180 specialty stores and eateries.
